- 4. Old Business:
  - Erosion control along east side of the west pond to be completed over Fall Break.

  - New oak tree by the pool has been staked.
- 5. Correspondence:
  - Review project request for shed. Board discussed and approved the plan.
  - Written inquiry from a neighbor concerning a brush pile that needs to be pick-up. The city truck did not pick up the brush pile as had been requested last week. Kristi will send a note back concerning the property.
  - One trailer violation inquiry has been sent to a resident requesting information concerning the trailer.
